- 1.1 Sight and sound of something heavenly
- 1.2 Granted, not seized (1:11)
- 1.3 Unearthly and holy in nature
- 1.4 Visions in the Bible: Abraham's dream (Gen.15); Jacob's dream (Gen.28:10-16); Moses on Sinai (Ex.34:1-8); Isaiah's vision & call (Is.6); Daniel's vision of "One like "Son of Man" (Dan.7; also Dan.8:); Jesus' transfiguration (Matt.17:1-8); Paul's glimpse into "3rd heaven" (II Cor.12:1-7)

2.0 Visions into Holiness

- 2.1 Holiness involves purity + separation
- 2.2 God is "holy, holy, holy" (ls.6:3)
- 2.3 John's vision of a holy Jesus:
 - vv.12-13 "Son of Man"
 - v.13 radiant clothing (Ex.28)
 - vv.14-15 glorious appearance (Dan.7:9; Matt.17:2)
 - v.16 double-edged sword (Heb.4:12-13)
 - v.17 "first and last" (// 1:4,8 = Alpha/Omega;

Who Is, He Was, Who-is-to-Come)

- v.18 once dead, now very much alive
- all 1:12-20; 5:9-14; 14:1-5; 19:5-10; 20:4; 21:23; 22:10-17
- 2.4 God's renders people holy (Lev.20:7; Deut.7:6)
- 3.0 Experiencing Holiness It Changes People.
